Charging Policy

1. The provisions of the 1988 Education Reform Act will be followed.
2. In addition to free provision of education during the school day, pupils who are entitled to free school meals will not be charged board and lodging where otherwise applicable to residential activities. The headteacher undertakes that parents will be told of the right to claim free activities if they are receiving this benefit.
3. Charges will normally be made for the following activities:
 - a) Board and lodging on residential visits
 - b) The proportionate cost for an individual child of activities wholly or mainly outside school hours ("optional extras") to meet the costs of :
 - Travel
 - Materials and equipment
 - Entrance fees
 - Insurance costs
 - c) Individual instrumental or vocal teaching in groups
 - d) Breakfast Club sessions.
 - e) After School Club sessions.
 - f) Any other education, transport or examination fees unless charges are specially prohibited.
 - g) FSA fundraising events held in school
 - h) Extra-curricular clubs run by outside agencies
